From that point, Off The Fence began initially as street outreach for rough sleepers across Brighton & Hove



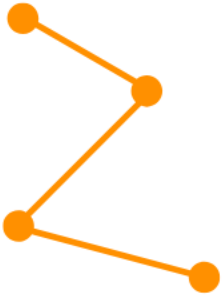
We now provide 3 poverty-tackling and prevention programmes
